



## 2022 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

In an effort to promote Idaho's sheep industry and provide support for student's interested in pursuing sheep-related careers, the Idaho Wool Growers Association is offering two \$1,000 scholarships for students enrolled at a college or university. The funds from this scholarship were raised through the Promo Ewe from the 100th Idaho Ram Sale, directly from contributions made from Idaho Sheep Producers.

### ELIGIBILITY:

1. Academic standing must be a college sophomore level or above. Graduate students are eligible.
2. Must be majoring in an agriculture-related field of study, agricultural sciences, or veterinary medicine, with a career interest in the sheep industry.
3. Applicants must be Idaho residents.
4. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average.
5. Preference will be given to children of Idaho Wool Grower Association members, but membership is not required to apply.
6. Recipient is not required to attend an Idaho college or university, but preference will be given to those students.

- Applicants must submit the following materials:
  - Completed Scholarship Application
  - Official transcript
  - Resume
  - Two Letters of Recommendation
