

2023 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

In an effort to promote Idaho's sheep industry and provide support for student's interested in pursuing sheep-related careers, the Idaho Wool Growers Association is offering two \$1,000 scholarships for students enrolled at a college or university. The funds from this scholarship were raised through the Promo Ewe from the 101st Idaho State Ram Sale, directly from contributions made from Idaho Sheep Producers.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Academic standing must be a college sophomore level or above. Graduate students are eligible.
- 2. Preference is given to students majoring in an agriculture-related or natural resources-related fields of study, agricultural sciences, or veterinary medicine, with a career interest in the sheep industry. Other majors will be considered.
- 3. Applicants must be Idaho residents.
- 4. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average.
- 5. Preference will be given to children of Idaho Wool Grower Association members, but membership is not required to apply.
- 6. Applicants must be University of Idaho students.

TO APPLY:

- Applicants must submit the following materials:
 - Completed Scholarship Application
 - Transcript (official or unofficial will be accepted)
 - Resume
 - List two references that may be called upon if needed


